IN ORDER TO APPLY FOR AN EMERGENCY PASSPORT TO REPLACE A LOST OR STOLEN PASSPORT, YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE RECENT (LESS THAN SIX MONTHS OLD), HIGH-QUALITY PHOTOGRAPHS (PLEASE NOTE THAT PHOTO BOOTHS ARE NOT SET TO AUSTRALIAN STANDARDS).

IF YOU DID NOT BRING PHOTOGRAPHS, THE FOLLOWING PHOTOGRAPHERS ARE FAMILIAR WITH AUSTRALIAN PASSPORTS PHOTO STANDARDS.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT AUSTRALIAN AND SPANISH PASSPORT PHOTOGRAPHS HAVE DIFFERENT STANDARDS. REMIND YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER THAT YOU NEED <u>AUSTRALIAN</u> PASSPORT PHOTOGRAPHS.

IF YOUR PHOTOGRAPHS DO NOT MEET THE STANDARDS DETAILED BELOW, YOUR APPLICATION COULD BE DELAYED.

- Good quality, colour gloss prints, less than six months old
- Clear, focused image with no marks or 'red eye'
- Plain white or light grey background that contrasts with your face
- Uniform lighting (no shadows or reflections) with appropriate brightness and contrast to show natural skin tone
- Face looking directly at the camera and not tilted in any direction
- Hair off the face so that the edges of the face are visible
- Eyes open, mouth closed
- If you wear glasses, we suggest you remove them for the photograph
- Neutral expression (not smiling, laughing or frowning), which is the easiest way for border systems to match you to your image.
